At 9 am, colourful and innovative charts were displayed at every counter. The stalls ranged from eatables to apparel. The eatables included Sandwiches, cupcakes, burgers, and sweets. Each item was so delicious that most of the stock was sold out by lunchtime. Some counters displayed trendy Indian wear for women as well as leather ware for men. The activity taught us how to manage risk and to work with limited budgets for a short period. They also learned how to multitask and allocate work according to the strengths and weaknesses of the team members. The sales and profit margins boosted our morale. Overall, the activity was a great learning experience, and it helped us 'young entrepreneurs' sharpen our managerial skills.

Abhimaan Club organized a motivational talk and blood donation camp on 18th November and 19th November 2015 in association with Bhagwati Hospital, Borivali West.

On 19th November 2015, Abhimaan Club of St. Francis Institute of Management and Research (SFIMAR) successfully conducted the annual 'Blood Donation Camp' as part of Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) activities. The camp was organized in association with Bhagwati Hospital, Borivali (West).

Abhimaan Club conducted a pre-event for the Blood Donation on 18th Nov for the students, faculty and staff. The College invited Dr. Shubha Raul, ex-mayor of Mumbai, as the chief guest for the pre-event. Also invited were resource persons from Bhagwati Hospital who shed light on critical information related to blood donation. The doctors from Bhagwati Hospital clarified facts regarding blood donation, like eligibility of donors and popular myths surrounding blood donation. Dr. Shubha Raul, with her inspiring speech, appealed to the young crowd to regularly donate blood to contribute to the nation's service. She mentioned her own experience of donating blood for the first time to motivate the girls who wanted to donate blood for the first time. She further gave examples of people who donate blood to lead a healthy life.

The pre-event talks presented by eminent people certainly motivated the young crowd of the College. Students and staff enthusiastically came out for donating blood the next day, taking time from their busy academic schedule. After inquiring about essential background information, donors were tested for blood pressure and hemoglobin by doctors from the Bhagwati Hospital. Eligible donors were then carefully guided through the blood donation process by the nursing staff. Like every year, Abhimaan Club Faculty Coordinator, Prof Dr. G. Ramesh, was the first to donate blood. Student coordinators kept note of every registration and wrote the names of successful donors on the hall of fame board at the venue entrance.

The camp was a significant event for many first-time donors. For every donor, there were certificates and badges awarded as a token of appreciation.

Objectives:

- To raise awareness that individuals can save lives and improve the health of others by donating blood.
- To encourage people to donate blood voluntarily without compensation.
- To support the operation of safe and reliable blood services.

Learning Outcome:

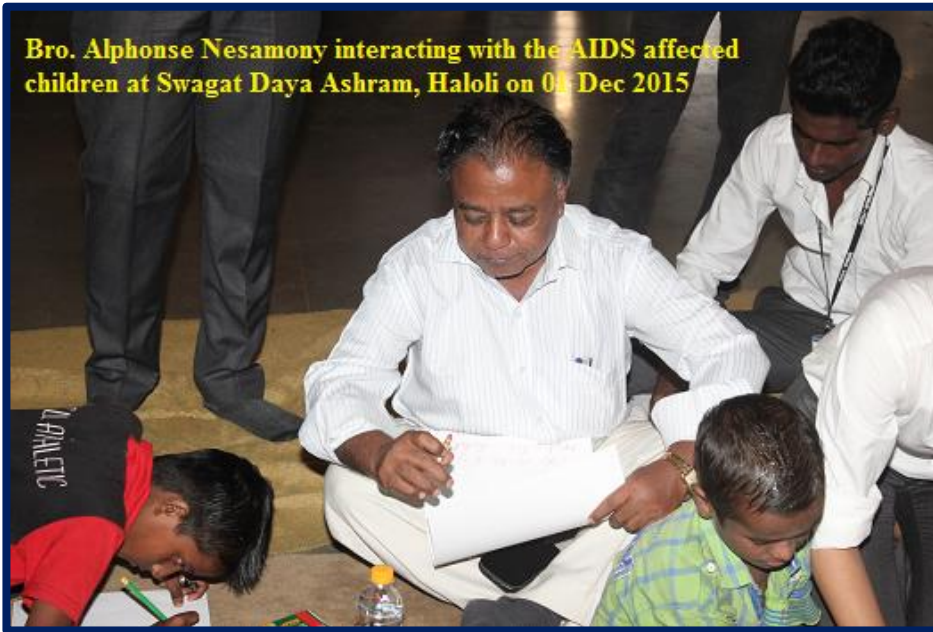

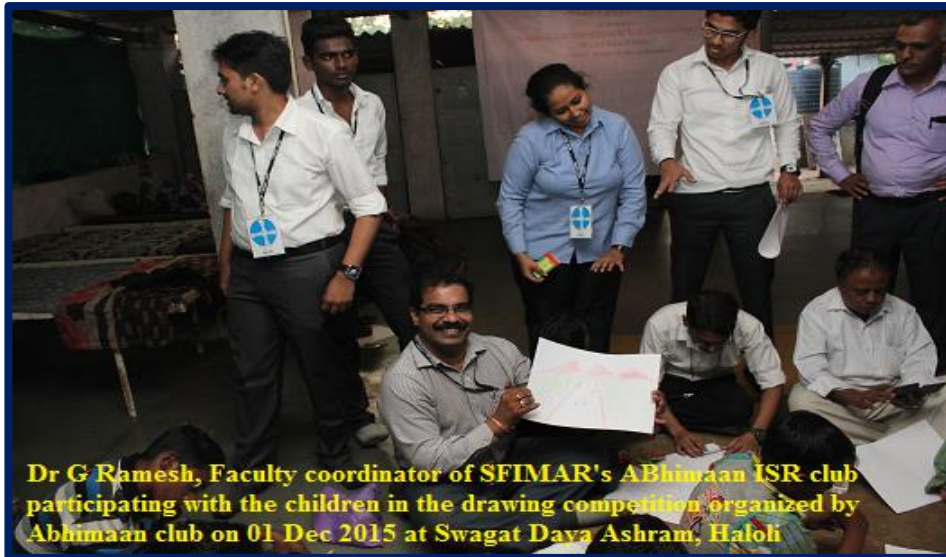

Many children fall prey to sexual abuse by adults and sometimes older children. Many (15-20%) of adults report that children were abused or inappropriately touched. Children from all socioeconomic classes are affected. This experience can leave intense emotional scars on children and affect their development as happy, healthy adults. This workshop aimed to educate children about safe/good and unsafe/bad touch. They also educated children about three body parts (chest, bottom, and between legs) that anyone cannot touch. They also taught them how to protect themselves if such a thing happens. All in all, it was a pleasant experience interacting with the children and teaching them how to stay safe.

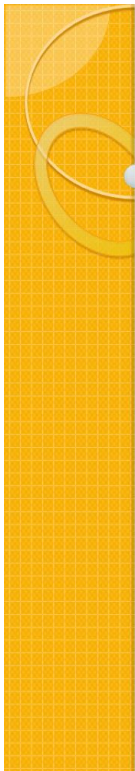

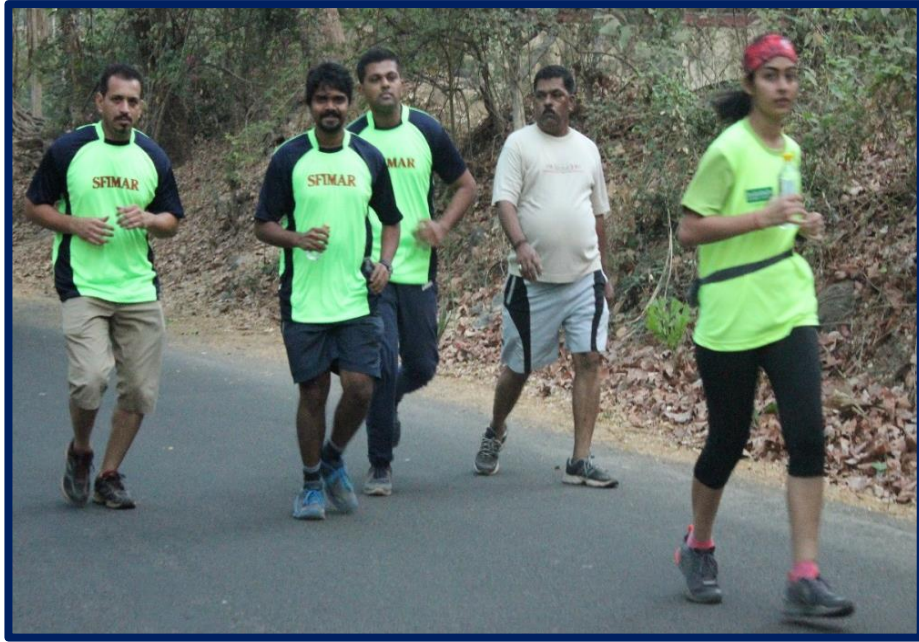

“Skill development is the path towards successful career” - Dr. Sulbha Raorane

Dr. Sulbha Raorane expressed her views on the television show 'Careers in Commerce' aired on the Jai Maharashtra Marathi News Channel. She discussed various options available in the job market after graduating in Commerce and the different ways of preparing during the graduation period for maximising the chances of getting a good job.

She advised students to check their self-interest before joining the commerce or any other stream by going through the syllabus, which is easily available online and with the relevant colleges. She advised going through subjects like mathematics, statistics, etc. before joining any branch of commerce to assess the ability to cope with these subjects. Only after thoroughly studying the contents of the syllabus should one choose his or her career path and sector.

Dr. Raorane said that if students wish to enjoy and attain success in their course and in their career the first thing they need to do is to recognise their strengths and develop skills which are essential for being successful. Skills development is the path towards a successful career.

Commerce students can utilize their time even after college hours for skill development. Good written and Spoken English is a necessary skill, as English is the global business language. Developing communication skills can open up ample opportunities for a bright career in all the sectors. The introduction of courses in digital marketing have gained ground in the recent years as the business and social world has gone online.

Over the last decade many multinational companies have been setting up their businesses in India. These companies require skilful employees, fluent in English and good at interpersonal communication. Dr.Raorane urged students to develop their communication skills and aptitude. These skills can be developed post college hours. After a degree in commerce, opting for an MBA is a good option. These days a degree in MBA is offered with various specializations like family business, entrepreneurship, etc. Those who wish to develop their family business could choose opting for such specializations for focusing on developing their skills.

Students need to plan their career from the very first job that they take up. It is important to have a vision of what is to be achieved in the next 5 years. Focussing on the career goal is the right way to start a career. Dr. Sulbha Raorane finally added that with changing times and trends, only a formal degree is not enough. Students also have to develop their soft skills among other skills for surviving and thriving in the job market.

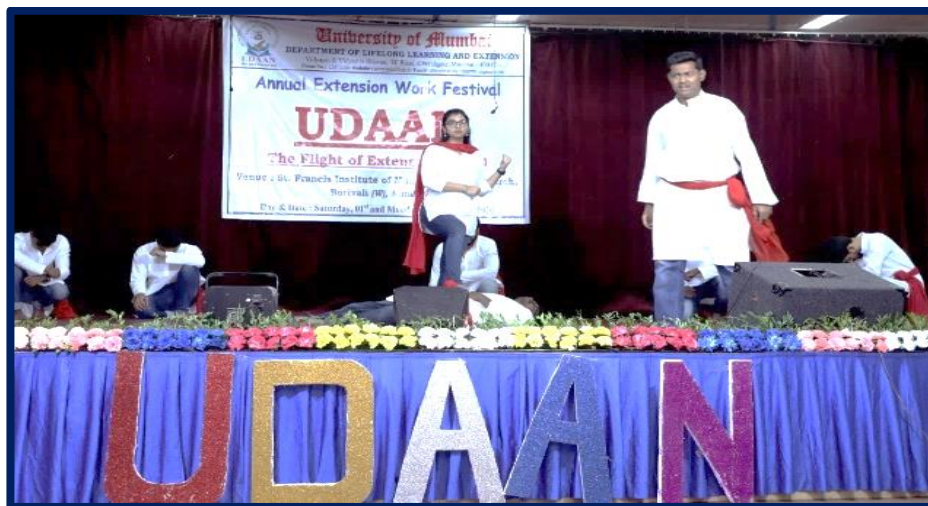

Hydroponic system of cropping in SFIMAR Campus

SFIMAR Green Club members discussed and decided to carry out a research study on the hydroponic system of cropping on a practical note. The project aimed to establish organic vegetable cultivation using a hydroponic cropping technique on a small scale in about 200 to 300 square feet of land. The project concentrated on cultivating vegetable crops/green leaves using mineral nutrients solutions, in water, without soils. Students of the 2019-21 batch took the initiative and cultivated spinach on the campus.

During the lockdown period in 2020, proper care of saplings was not feasible, which led to further damage, but the institute took immediate action post lockdown to improve the situation. Beautification was done in the front part of the institute. Also, because of lockdown, the hydroponic initiative was stopped. Later rose saplings were planted in that area.
